

INDUSTRY PUBLIC UTILITIES 2022 WATER SYSTEM CONNECTION CAPACITY CHARGES

When potable water service is requested for property or premises not previously provided water service by the Industry Public Utilities, a one-time capacity charge for water system connection will be assessed. In the event use of the property changes and an increase in size of the water system connection is requested, a capacity charge for the difference in meter size of the connection will also be assessed. The capacity charge is assessed for each property (or premises) to bear its proportionate share of the cost of the water system facilities in relation to the benefit that the property receives. The charge is calculated based on the hydraulic capacity of the service being requested.

The table below shows the 2022 capacity charge for water system connection based upon meter size:
